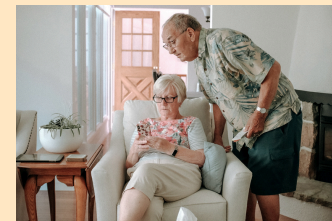

19 October 2024 - Filing deadline for the CIS300 monthly return for the month ended 5 October 2024.

19 October 2024 - CIS tax deducted for the month ended 5 October 2024 is payable by today.
